Ethical Behaviour	
<p><b>Inherent Requirement</b></p> <p>x Behave ethically and professionally in academic and professional environments, complying with relevant standards and codes of ethics applicable to the profession.</p>	
<p><b>Rationale</b></p> <p>x Compliance with relevant professional standards and/or codes of conduct, and commonly accepted standards of professional behaviour facilitates safe, competent interactions and relationships for students and the people they engage with in all contexts. This supports the physical, psychological, emotional and spiritual wellbeing of all.</p> <p>Related Professional Requirements:</p>	
<p><b>Examples</b></p> <p>x Reflect on ethical dilemmas and issues, and take responsibility for ensuring awareness of ethical behaviour</p> <p>x Understanding relevant issues and the strategies to support the safe, responsible and ethical use of Information and Communication Technologies (ICT).</p>	



- x Comprehend spoken English delivered at conversational speed.

ICT Capacity
<p><b>Inherent Requirement</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>x Acquire, and employ information and communications technology (ICT) skills in an appropriate and effective manner, utilising a range of systems in both the academic and professional setting.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Rationale</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>x Competent ICT skills are essential to successfully access, apply and communicate information.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Examples</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>x Submit assessment items online.</li> <li>x Use ICT to access information and to complete assessment tasks as required.</li> <li>x Use ICT in the professional setting, including the use of a range of industry standard software packages.</li> <li>x Use ICT for image editing, video editing and audio editing.</li> </ul>

Sustainable Performance
<p><b>Inherent requirements</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>x Complete tasks in a timely manner and within a designated period, where required, maintaining consistency and quality of performance.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Rationale</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>x Sufficient physical and mental endurance is an essential requirement needed to perform multiple tasks assigned period to provide safe and effective services.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Examples</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>x Remain focussed and provide consistent responses over the course of a professional placement.</li> <li>x Perform multiple tasks in an assigned period with a level of concentration that ensures a capacity to focus the activity until it is completed appropriately.</li> </ul>
