### ACADEMIC ENGLISH ELIGIBILITY

<b>AE1</b>	AE1 is the first Academic English level. To be eligible for this level, you must have obtained an IELTS score of 4.5/4.5 (or equivalent) or successfully completed our GE3 course. After graduating, you can progress to level AE2.
<b>AE2</b>	AE2 requires you to have gained an IELTS score of 5.0/5.0 (or equivalent) or completed level AE1. Passing your AE2 means you can gain entry into the UC International Foundation program and UC College diploma courses without further IELTS testing.
<b>AE3</b>	Entry into AE3 requires an IELTS or equivalent score of 5.5/5.5 or the successful completion of AE2. Successful completion of this course allows you to gain entry into UC undergraduate degrees with standard entry requirements. No further IELTS test is required.
<b>AE4</b>	AE4 requires an IELTS or equivalent score of 6.0/6.0 or the successful completion of AE3. If you pass your AE4, you can gain entry into our University's Master's degrees with standard entry requirements. You can also gain entry into degrees with higher than standard entry requirements to a maximum of IELTS 7.0 or equivalent. No further IELTS test is required.
